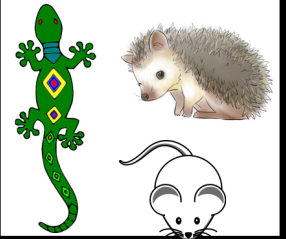




Early Years Curriculum Newsletter



We would like to send out a big welcome to all our pupils in Early Years and send a special welcome to the new pupils that have joined us this term. We hope you all had an enjoyable spring break and have come back ready to take part in a very exciting summer term.

For the first half of the term we are learning about 'Journeys and transports'.

The children will enjoy exploring different types of ways to travel, choose destinations and go on trips to local places around the school.

We are all looking forward to an exciting visit from the book people, they are telling us a multisensory story in multiple small sessions.

During this half term and hope the children will enjoy exploring different types of transports (trains, road transports, water transports and air.

Our playground has got a new floor trampoline installed, children are enjoying jumping while learning rhythm, turn taking and developing their bodies.



Communication and Language

This Term the pupils will continue to learn about books and explore stories, through a sensory and interactive approach. The pupils will be involved in singing and rhyme sessions- all pupils will be encouraged to take part, copying actions and singing and signing the words. We will also continue to develop our listening and concentration skills through a range of activities and play situations. The pupils will be learn a variety of new and exciting words, sounds and signs linked to the topic and activities.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

As part of Personal, Social and Emotional Development-We will be supporting pupils to continue to develop positive relationships with others and will also continue to develop individual play skills both in the classroom and as part of outdoor activities.

We will be encouraging pupils to be as independent as possible within familiar environments and support them to join in with activities that encourage interaction and self help skills.
