We at Lindon Bennett would like to welcome back all the children and the families and hope that you've all been staying safe. It's a slightly different start to the year with children having a staggered start back to school the last group of children will be returning on the 28th September 2020.

Where I live:

This half term the children will be learning about homes and where they live. They will explore the materials that homes are made from and visit each others homes virtually and construct different types of homes. With your support from home, the children will learn about routines that take place at home and who the members of their families are. They will see how houses are transformed when families are celebrating festivals that take place during the year. The children will have an opportunity to visit the shops on the local high street with safety being paramount at all times and will role play a variety of settings in the classroom and outdoor environment.

The outside learning opportunities in our community are limited due to the regulations in place because of Covid.

Fairy stories (The twelve days of Christmas):

In the second half of the autumn term the children will be introduced the fairy tales; The gingerbread man, The elves and the shoemaker, The 12 days of Christmas, The princess and the frog, Jack and the beanstalk and Snow White and the 7 dwarves. They will be undertaking a variety of activities linked to development matters.

Communication and Language

This term the pupils will continue to develop their individual communication skills to make requests. The children will join in with singing and rhyme sessions- all pupils will be encouraged to take part, copying actions and singing the words. We will also continue to develop our listening and concentration skills through a range of activities and play situations. The pupils will be learn a variety of new and exciting words and sounds linked to the topic and activities.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development As part of Personal, Social and Emotional Development - we will be supporting pupils to continue to develop positive relationships with others and will also continue to develop individual play skills both in the classroom and as part of outdoor activities. We will be encouraging pupils to be as independent as possible within familiar environments and support them to join in with activities that encourage interaction and self help skills.
