All about me:

This half term we will be starting with the topic 'All about me'. It's a fun introduction to the start of the new academic year that gives the children a chance to share their qualities and their home life with their peers. The children will learn more about their senses and discover more about their likes and dislikes in a variety of different areas including taste and smell. They will learn about how to care for their bodies and show kindness to each other. The children will celebrate their uniqueness and differences with each other and will also get the opportunity to go on some lovely trips within the local community.

Space and (The twelve days of Christmas):

In the second half of the autumn term we will be focusing on the topic of space starting off with our amazing planet earth. They will have a chance to explore maps and globes and different environments. The children will be able to learn more about the world we live in through trips and visits beyond the classroom and will begin to explore the other celestial bodies that make up our solar system in a fun way that involves some science exploration and observing cause and effect. In the last couple of weeks of the term we will concentrate on the celebration of Christmas.

We will also continue to develop our listening and concentration skills through a range of activities and play situations.
